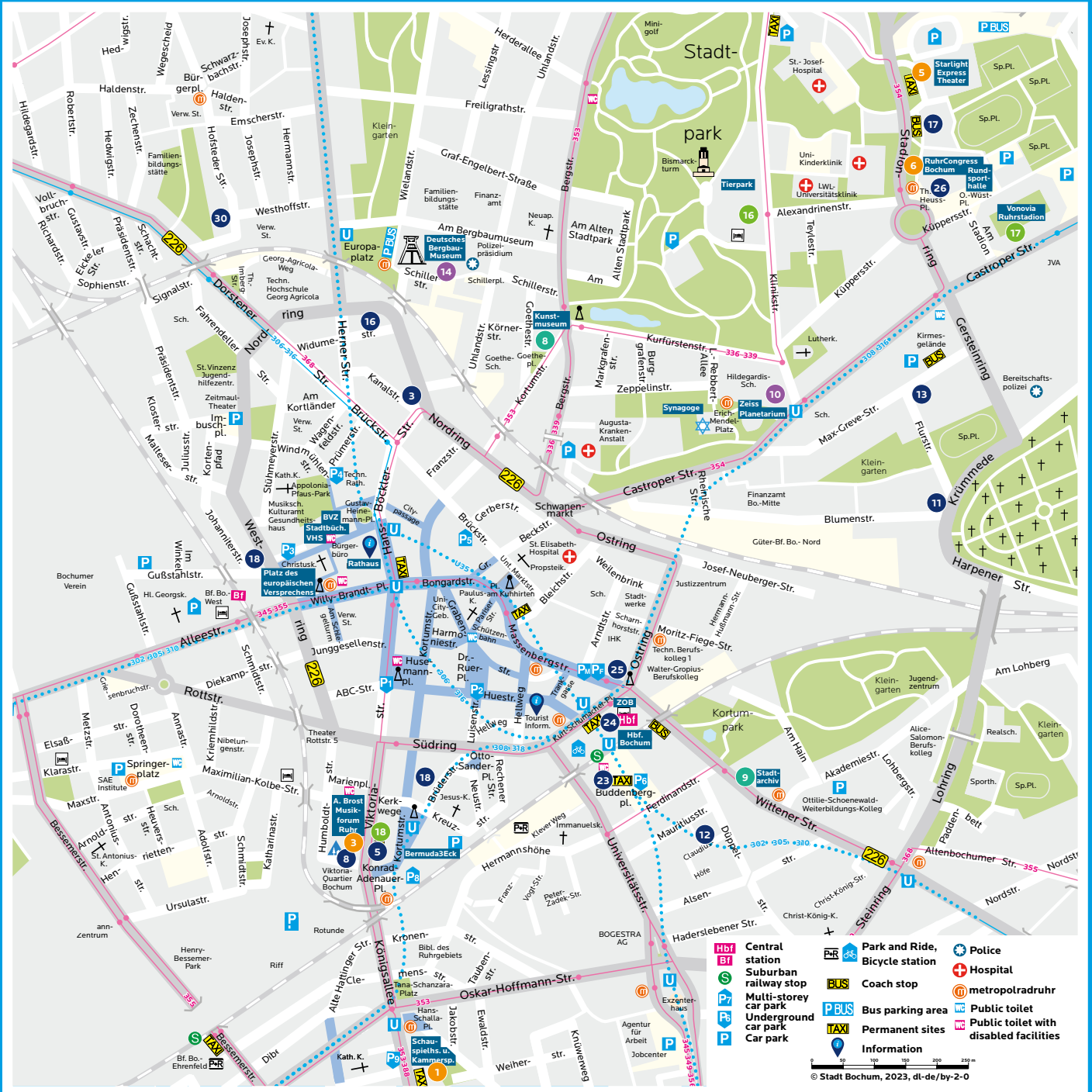

3 Anneliese Brost Musikforum Ruhr

Although the Anneliese Brost Musikforum Ruhr is one of Bochum's newest cultural showpieces, it can still draw on a wealth of tradition. Home to the Bochumer Symphoniker orchestra, it was ceremonially opened in October 2016 and boasts two performance halls, the larger of which holds up to 960 people. Concerts are also held in the former Church of St. Mary, which was integrated into the new concert building as

a foyer. In addition to the varied programme of the Bochumer Symphoniker, Bochum's School of Music – one of the largest in Germany – also uses the music forum for rehearsals and concerts.

5 Starlight Express

6 RuhrCongress Bochum



In 2001, the RuhrCongress Bochum was constructed between the Starlight Express Theatre and Ruhr Stadium as a new event centre that meets all modern technical and conceptual requirements. The 7,500 square meter building not only serves as a centre for large-scale trade fairs, conferences, galas and conventions, but also features a comprehensive annual programme of cul-

tural events. The RuhrCongress transforms from a venue for rock, pop and jazz concerts into a stage for dancing tournaments or a live arena for comics and cabaret artists.

The Museum unter Tage (MuT) was constructed underground to preserve the surrounding landscape. 9 **City archives – the Bochum centre for municipal history**

The city's anniversary celebrations may be over, but there is still much to tell about Bochum's 700-year history. In the city archives, the permanent exhibition „Bochum in the making. Highlights from Bochum's history“ casts a fresh eye over the anniversary. Instead of an all-encompassing retrospective, this free exhibition focuses on a few key, selected moments in the city's development, which are presented using exciting and modern techniques. This ensures that visitors can take away a great deal from the exhibition. The city archives serve as the city's memory, where stories from Bochum's history can be researched, discovered and experienced.

15 Lake Kemnade & skatepark

Lake Kemnade is the blue jewel of the Ruhr area. In addition to a leisure pool, the lake offers sailing and surfing courses, boat hire, a kite buggy and land sailing school, excursions on the MS Kemnade passenger ship and a beach bar – the StrandDeck – with 1,500 square metres of the finest sandy beach. The paved Ruhr-inline skating route extends for ten kilometres around Lake Kemnade,

making it ideal for roller-skating fun. Thanks to the state-of-the-art LED mast lamps along the route, skating fans can keep on rolling until 11.00 p.m.

16 Tierpark Bochum



Bochum Zoo and Fossilium are home to around 4,000 animals from over 300 species! Visitors can view cheeky meerkats, ring-tailed lemurs and graceful flamingos in modern enclosures that mimic their natural habitats. Seals, penguins and wading birds bring the „North Sea Worlds“ experience to life. Summer 2020 saw the opening of a new „Asia Worlds“ zone, covering an area of 800 square metres. Visitors can immerse themselves in the fascinating natural habitats of South-East Asia

and discover lively river dwellers, skilled climbers, highly vocal birds and nocturnal jungle dwellers. The interactive „Jungle Up Close“ exhibition opened in spring 2022 and transports visitors to the world inhabited by South-East Asia's nocturnal animals.

Cycling

A new route network on former railway lines, bicycle hire, free charging stations for e-bikes and a large number of cycle paths make Bochum a popular destination for cyclists. The city's location also provides the ideal base for cycling tours to neighbouring cities, with Herne, Witten, Gelsenkirchen, Essen and Dortmund all just a short bike ride away. And that naturally also includes key sites from the area's industrial history, like the Jahrhunderthalle,

the UNESCO World Heritage Zollverein complex and the Nachtigall Colliery of the LWL Museum of Industrial Heritage. The route along Erzbahntrasse from Bochum to Gelsenkirchen is 13 kilometres long. The Ruhrtal cycle path starts in Winterberg, before passing through Bochum and finishing at the Rhine in Duisburg. This 230-kilometre route along the Ruhr boasts a dense network of bike-friendly facilities.

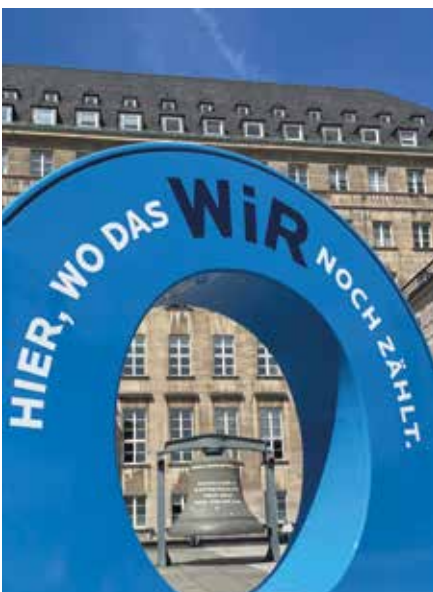
